Last week the year 6s spent 2 nights at an outdoor activity Centre called Kingswood.



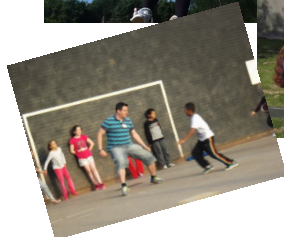
Children took part in a variety of exciting and thrill seeking activities such as quad biking, Climbing, zip wire, scrapheap challenge, archery, orienteering and night line.
