This letter is to remind all parents of our **Reading/ Homework Diary** which your child should bring home each day.

At Donnington Wood CE Junior School we strive to encourage all pupils to develop important learning habits and discipline which will help them make outstanding progress at our school and beyond. Part of this involves taking responsibility for homework and reading for pleasure at home.

The log book has a number of sections we ask that you make regular use of.

Reading log page – We expect all pupils to be reading regularly at home and to keep a record of this. Please encourage your child to read a wide range of books and to record book titles and pages completed, and we ask you to comment on the stories/ information they have read.

Spellings to learn – Each week pupils will receive a targeted word list for them to practice and learn to spell. Please help them by revising these with them in preparation for class tests.

Homework to complete - Whenever homework tasks are set each week, reminders can be recorded in the logbook. Times-tables charts are included at the back for regular revision.

Messages to teachers or parents – Please use this book to send messages and comments to class teachers. Teachers will also use this book to send important messages and reminders home to you too.

Important events and reminders– the book also contains pages to record weekly and termly events.

We expect every pupil to look after and use these books, bringing them to school each day. Books are now being checked every Wednesday and rewards and prizes issued for the best kept examples. Homework and reading diaries not being submitted will result in pupils losing Golden Time.
