- 1) Most important rule! If you are worried about anything; speak to family members, friends or trusted adults.
- 2) Check the age ratings: NO DONNINGTON WOOD PUPILS ARE OLD ENOUGH TO BE ON OR BE USING the social media sites listed below.

13 year old Twitter, Facebook Instagram, Pinterest, Tumblr, Reddit, Snapchat and Secret.

The minimum age on LinkedIn is 14. On WhatsApp it's 16, Vine it's 17. Some platforms, such as YouTube, WeChat and Kik, have a minimum age required of 18, although children aged 13-17 can signup with parent's permission.

Tik Tok age limit to 13 Years Old.

Computer games: CALL OF DUTY IS 18! but at least half of the pupils in school said they had played it.
