

## **My Day Green Group Plan**

Run by Miss Owen, First aider and Mrs Poyner, Assistant head and dependent on numbers, supported by one other member of staff.

### **Purpose**

To bring more pupils back to school in a controlled and engaging way, to reduce anxieties and to have face to face contact with pupils before we introduce more formal Transition work.

Your child does not need to attend, and you will need to make a decision based on the information we have shared below. We would love to see them but only if you are certain.

### **Main Controls of risk**

- Temp Check on arrival
- Activities take place on Field
- Limited time initially.
- Limited numbers (Max 30 spread out between the 2 adults.)
- Socially distant activities. (3 meters plus) with teachers more than 5 meters)
- Parents are not allowed on site/ or congregating outside.
- There would be no shared equipment, with activities based on athletics and games such as Mrs Poyner says, running races and non-contact games.

**We cannot guarantee 100% safety** but we feel with these controls in place we can start welcoming back more pupils. Depending on the success of it will roll it out further.

### **Frequently asked questions we have had from other parents**

Where will we wait? Not around the gate, line up down the pavement away from school. When it is time to enter, your child will be called forward and have their temp taken. You will then need to depart by crossing the road, by the gate and departing.

What happens if it thunders? If it was not predicted, we would take the to the hall and wait socially distantly. We will do a different range of activities sat 2m apart. WE WILL NOT RUN IF RAIN IS PREDICTED/Or is falling.

Toilets: It is time limited so most would not need the toilet, however, we would use Red group 2/3 toilet, and are trying to source portaloos. These would be cleaned between groups.

I am worried about sending my child back, what should I do? If you have any doubts, wait, there will be other opportunities, but rest assured we have taken lots of precautions, more so that you will find in any shop or in the community. You will need to decide to send your child or not.

### **Rules and expectations (TAKE FROM MAIN MY DAY)**

#### **As a parent/carer, I will ensure that:**

- My child arrives on time. I agree that my child will not be allowed into school if they are late.
- My child wears clothes that are suitable for PE and games.
- I will send my child in with a clean, filled water bottle, they will not come to school with a big bag. If needed, I will apply sun lotion and provide a hat.
- I will not congregate with other adults outside of school and will not enter the school site.

- As a family, we will abide by social distancing rules out of school. The school bubble will keep my child's group safe from cross contamination, but it relies on all of us not breaking the government rules.
- I WILL CHECK MY CHILD'S TEMPERATURE AND SYMPTOMS BEFOREHAND and not send them in if symptoms show. I agree to school using a hand-held thermometer to check my child's temperature each day.
- I agree to school closing to my child's group if any child in the group is sent home with suspected symptoms until a test has been completed.
- If required, I will get my child tested and report the result to school.
- I will collect my child from school immediately on request by school. This may be due to illness or my child's failure to comply with the school's revised behaviour plan and safety guidelines.
- I have supplied the school office with my current contact details.

If any of these rules are not followed, we will not allow your child on to site as the risk would be deemed 'unmanageable.'

**Our Actions:**

2 days before the allotted day we will text you the times.

If you want your child to attend, reply with the name of child. You have one day to do this. After this we cannot provide a place.

If your child is shielding, they need to continue this, we will contact you before hand if they have any medical conditions that have a higher risk and you want your child to attend.

Arrive at the Bottom gate only, at your start time, there is a 10 minute window, and to avoid overcrowding, you can come towards the end of it. You cannot arrive after the 10 minutes as Miss Owen will no longer be taking temperatures and the gate will be locked.

Queue down the pavement, making space for everyone. Children need to remain with their parents (this will be hard as they will be excited, but it is so important they cannot mix).

**If rain is forecast we will move the dates.**

Your child will enter one at a time. They will have their temp checked and Alcohol Gel their hands. They will then move to their allocated start point, Mrs Poyner will direct them.

When it is time to finish, they will be sent to the gate one at a time, they will gel their hands and walk to you. Please do not block the gate.

Unfortunately there is no flexibility with dates for this first time and <b>these are proposed times only at minute (we will look at the weather forecast)</b>
We will text you on ? (to be confirmed) We need a reply by ?
1:30- 2:30 Arrive 1:30- 1:35 and collected 2:30 – 2:35

If there are any problems or issues we will contact you immediately.

We may have to cancel events, for a number of reasons, but will let you know ASAP

We know many of you are anxious about the return to school, rest assured, we are the same loving and caring Team we always have been. We will spend part of the session talking through worries and concerns with pupils.

We are so thankful for all your support. We look forward to seeing you, when we see you!

### **Next Steps**

We will review this and then see what we can offer in the next few weeks, and we are planning transition towards the end of term.

Morrisons have made a massive donation of food to us, and dependent on availability we will send home a back, (this will be sorted using gloves and put in bags.

We will also send home the physical Seesaw password sheets.
