Arriving at school.



- ▶ Please ensure that you arrive on time. If you are late, you may not be permitted into school.
- ▶ Please abide by social distancing rules and remain 2m away from anyone else.
- ▶ Once you are permitted into school, you must make your way to your designated classroom (this will not necessarily be your usual classroom).

Arriving at your classroom



- Wait on the chalk lines (2m distanced) until you are called in to class

Arriving at your classroom



- ▶ Your temperature will be taken by a member of staff who will be wearing full PPE (a visor, gloves and an apron)

This is for your safety as much as theirs.

- ▶ If you are displaying a high temperature then you will need to return home.

Entering the classroom




- You will keep ALL of your belongings with you. These must be placed on, or under, your table.
- You will be assigned your own table that you will use throughout the week.

Entering the classroom



- ▶ Once you have placed your belongings at your table, you will be asked to wash your hands.
- ▶ The tap will already be running and you will leave it running so as to avoid lots of people touching the tap.
- ▶ You will need to use soap and wash them for 2 minutes.
- ▶ You will use a paper towel to dry your hands which will then be placed in to the bin alongside.
- ▶ You may then return to your seat.

Your desk and working in class



- ▶ You will be provided with everything you need in order to work successfully.

Tissues

Hand gel

Ipad

Headphones

Paper/workbook

Pencils/pens

Whiteboard and pen

(You only need to bring a water bottle and coat)

Safety first



- ▶ School will be a one way system to avoid having to pass each other closely. Please follow the signs and listen to the adults who will direct you around school.

Safety first



- ▶ You will only be able to use the toilets in your own classroom area
- ▶ Only one child at anytime will be permitted into the toilets
- ▶ We will expect you to wash your hands and then sanitise them as well upon re-entering the classroom.

Safety first – feeling unwell



- ▶ If you become unwell during the school day, you will be asked to sit outside the classroom (If it is raining, this will be in the corridor)
- ▶ A first aider will come to see you, they will be wearing full PPE.
- ▶ You may be sent home depending on your symptoms.

Playtime



- ▶ Red group will be using the bottom yard for playtime.
- ▶ Whilst we will still expect everyone to remain at a safe distance, we will devise a range of fun activities that we can all enjoy.
- ▶ When the whistle is blown, you will stand still until you are called back to your classroom.

Playtime



- ▶ The adventure will not be in use

lunchtime



- ▶ You will be asked to wash your hands
- ▶ If you are packed lunch then you will have your desk cleaned and then proceed to eat at your table.
- ▶ School dinner's form red group will line up to the side of Miss Barden's classroom
- ▶ You will wait to be called forward

lunchtime



- ▶ You will enter the hall via the fire exit alongside the carpark
- ▶ You will collect your lunch and exit through the same door

lunchtime



- ▶ You will re-enter the school through the door near Mr Rawson's room and continue up the corridor to your classroom.
- ▶ You will return to your table which will have been cleaned whilst you were gone.



Safety first – fire drill or lockdown

- ▶ If the fire bell rings (one continuous long bell) then you will be directed to line up on the top yard in your groups.
- ▶ If lockdown occurs (several short, sharp bells) you will need to remain in your classroom or be directed to return to class promptly.



Safety first



- ▶ Hand washing throughout the day.
- ▶ Catching sneezes in tissues and sanitising hands once you have disposed of the tissue.
- ▶ Do not share resources or food.
- ▶ Keep a safe distance from others.
- ▶ Wear different, clean clothing each day.
