Queens Road, Donnington

(Temporary Prohibition Of Traffic) Order 2020

Borough of Telford & Wrekin (hereinafter referred to as 'the Council') being the highway authority for the length of road specified in the schedule to this order, are satisfied that the traffic in the said length of road should be regulated by reason of works being proposed to be executed on or near the said length of road.

The Council, in exercise of their powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following order:-

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed in the length of road specified in the Schedule to this order.
2. The Order shall come into operation on 7th October 2020 and may be cited as Borough of Telford & Wrekin Queens Road, Donnington (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2020
3. Article 1 of this Order shall not apply to motor vehicles being used to access property and premises which are only accessible from one or more of the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
4. Article 1 of this Order shall not apply to a motor vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes.

The purpose of the order is to protect the general public from any danger that may arise whilst highway improvement works are being undertaken.

This Order will become operative on Wednesday 7th October and will continue in force for a period not exceeding eighteen months or until the earlier completion of the works, expected to be 3 days.

The diversion route for vehicular traffic travelling eastbound will be via St Georges Road, St Matthews Road, Church Road

The diversion route for vehicular traffic travelling westbound will be vice versa
