#### **COVID** safety

PLEASE DO NOT COME TO SCHOOL IF YOU OR YOUR CHILD HAVE SYMPTOMS OF COVID. If you have symptoms get tested. Telford and Wrekin LA is promoting the getting of a test for most ailments, see their website. You do need to isolate for some of the symptoms.

Over the Christmas Break, we may still have to contact you to ask you to isolate because of a positive case. We will be directed by the Health Protection Hub.
